

ORDINANCE NO. 1

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF HOUSTON REGULATING THE
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON A PORTION OF HOUSTON COUNTY
STATE AID HIGHWAY #29 AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATION THEREOF**

The County Board of Houston County, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION I. The parking of trucks which, for the purpose of this ordinance, are defined to include pickups and vans of all kinds, is hereby prohibited on Houston County State Aid Highway #29 (also known as Elm Street in the City of La Crescent in said County) and on the West side thereof from the North line of Second Street North, northward to the south line of Third Street North.

Section II. Other parking at that part of the aforescribed location which is twenty feet North of the North line of Second Street North, northward a distance of 64 feet shall be restricted to ten minutes, Monday through Friday of each week during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., official time.

Section III. Violations of this ordinance are petty misdemeanors and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as provided by the laws of the State of Minnesota for petty misdemeanors.
